Please bring the following supplies with you to the workshop:

- 30-50 sheets of practice paper, 11" x 17" (Strathmore drawing series 400 and/or charcoal paper recommended)
- Pencil HB, 2B and 4B, and fine line marker (0.1 or 0.2 mm)
- Eraser
- Good quality 1" and 3: flat brushes
- 2" inexpensive soft flat brush
- Any kind of folded pen you already have. (Tim's pen "Radius" nibs, New Horizon folded nib (Paper & Ink Art) and Luthis Polillita folded pen recommended)
- A middle size (size 5 to 7) pointed brush and/or Pentel Color Brush
- Tools from nature: twigs, pine needles, seedpods, sticks and anything you wish to make marks
- Mixing brushes and dishes (small and middle size about 4" for wide tools)
- Water containers and pipettes
- One to two 6 well plastic palettes
- Ruler about 12-18"
- Pointed needle tool or tapered awl
- Binder clips
- Glue stick
- Double stick tape
- Masking tape
- Bone folder
- Cutter knife
- Small cutting board
- Scissors
- Bookbinding thread and a needle
- Apron and plastic gloves
- Your chosen text: 10 to 100 words

- Your favorite small chisel nibs
- Pointed nibs and holders
- Automatic pens #5 or #6
- Squeeze bottles or Fine liners
- Sumi stick ink
- Your choice of watercolor
