

Polymer Clay: Debbie Jackson

Please bring the following supplies with you to the workshop:
☐ 2 pounds of white Premo polymer clay
☐ 6-8 Two-ounce packs of assorted colors of Premo polymer clay
☐ Pair of sharp scissors
☐ X-acto or craft knife
☐ Pasta machine w/3" C-clamp if handy
☐ Acrylic roller
☐ Cutting blade for clay
☐ Needle tool
☐ Acrylic, glass or ceramic tile work surface
☐ Round acrylic tubes about 6" or more long in assorted widths
☐ Pair of medium length tweezers
☐ Pair of needle nosed pliers and wire cutters for jewelry making if handy
☐ 4"- 6" bone folder or firm plastic pot scraper
☐ Roll of parchment paper
☐ Rubber gloves and/or finger cots
☐ 1 pt. of 70% Isopropyl alcohol
☐ 6-8 assorted colors of Adirondack alcohol inks (1/2 oz. bottles)
☐ Spray/mister bottles for spritzing alcohol
☐ Tube of Loctite Super Glue Gel
☐ Note pad and pen
☐ Old newspaper if handy
☐ Red bricks, assorted sizes from 6x6", 9"x9" and 12"x12" of ceramic tiles, or empty plastic gallon milk jugs.
